### ORDINANCE No. 15-2018

## AN ORDINANCE ON COMPREHENSIVE PLAN CONSISTENCY REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONAL USE PERMITS

The Village Board of the Village of Bristol, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

### SECTION I. ADOPTION OF PROVISIONS.

Section 13-1-177 of the Village of Bristol Code of Ordinances is created to read as follows:

# Sec. 13-1-177 Comprehensive Plan Consistency Requirements and Conditional Use Permits.

Pursuant to Sec. 66.1001(2m)(b), a conditional use permit that may be issued by the Village of Bristol does not need to be consistent with the Village Comprehensive Plan.

State Law Reference: Sec. 66.1001(2m)(b), Wis. Stats.

#### SECTION II. SEVERABILITY.

If any provision of this Ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional or if the application of this Ordinance to any person or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or applications.

### SECTION III. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall take ef	fect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
